Supplies Needed:

Situation sheet, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart, and pencils

Reasons: B, C, A, D

B is over **C** because this keeps you on time for your game, but also helps out 1st year member

C is over **A** because you are helping the 1st year member, but missing your game means you will be letting down your teammates.

A is over **D** because you will make it to the game on time but still get your exhibits judged, whereas in **D** you may also be late for your game.

Situation:
