Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and Option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart and pencils.

Suggested Age: 8-10

Reasons:

- A** is placed first because when preparing food, one should always wash his or her hands before starting and as needed during the process to remove dirt and germs.
- D** is placed second so that Marshall will have a clean place to put his tomato after he washes it.
- B** is placed third because fruit and vegetables should always be washed before they are used.
- C** is placed last because before Marshall can slice the tomato he needs to have clean hands, a clean cutting board, and a clean tomato.





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Situation:

Marshall is packing his lunch to take to school. He wants to put tomato slices on his sandwich. What is the first thing he should do? Second? Third? Last?

Options:

A. Wash his hands.



B. Wash the tomato.
