Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and Option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart and pencils.

Suggested Age: 11-13

Reasons:

A is placed first because cereal is stored at room temperature.

C is placed second because the frozen orange juice concentrate will stay colder longer than a refrigerated item.

B is placed third because the milk will stay cold longer than the chicken.

D is placed last because the raw chicken is the most dangerous item to have at room temperature for any length of time.
