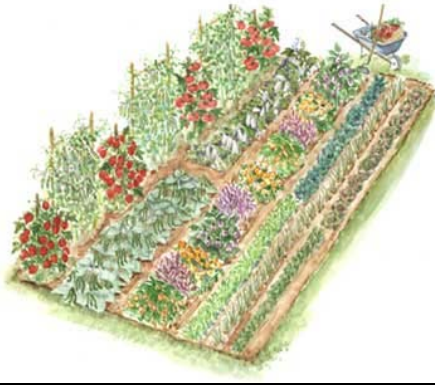
Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart and pencils.

Reasons:

- A.** Green beans, tomatoes, and bush cucumbers are all suitable for a small vegetable garden.
- D.** Green beans, pumpkin and watermelon are suitable for a Missouri garden, but the watermelon and pumpkin take up a lot of garden space.
- C.** All are plants and the green beans and watermelon should grow, but oranges are trees and not a good choice for small gardens.
- B.** Green beans and tomatoes are good vegetables, but macaroni is not a plant and will not grow if planted anywhere.
